On behalf of the members of the Los Angeles Kings Booster Club, we would like to welcome you to Southern California!

2017 marks a special year for hockey fans. It is the 50th anniversary of the Los Angeles Kings, one of six NHL expansion franchises that began play in October 1967. It is also the 100th anniversary of the NHL itself.

Your registration fees cover your hotel accommodations for Friday and Saturday nights, Friday and Saturday dinner, Saturday and Sunday breakfast, the annual meeting on Saturday morning, your arrival package and use of the hospitality rooms during posted hours.

Pre-convention activities will include transportation, admission fees, meals (when indicated) and driver gratuities. All trips will be filled by reservation on a first-come, first-served basis. We cannot guarantee refunds on any of the pre-convention trips unless a replacement is found to fill the spot. If not, any refund will be based on monies recovered from the attractions. However, the price of the bus will be passed onto the person who did not attend the trip.

All trips will leave at the posted times. If you miss the bus, you will be responsible for your return trip to the hotel. If there is an increase in a trip due to fuel costs, we reserve the right to charge an additional amount to cover those costs.

Your convention ID badge must be worn at all times while attending any NHLBCC function, including visits to the hospitality rooms during posted hours.

The legal drinking age in the state of California is 21. Per NHLBCC bylaws, no one younger than that age is permitted in a hospitality room while alcohol is being consumed.

Torrance, California

The City of Torrance was incorporated in 1921 and has a population of about 148,000. The city gets its name from real estate developer Jared Sidney Torrance, who was instrumental in creating its residential and industrial community.

Transportation to Los Angeles

Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) is about 8 miles from our hotel.

Long Beach Airport (LGB) is about 13 miles away and is served mainly by JetBlue and Southwest.

Other nearby airports include Bob Hope Airport (BUR) in Burbank, about 36 miles away, and John Wayne Orange County Airport (SNA), about 40 miles away.

Directions to the hotel:

From LAX: Exit the airport and take Sepulveda Blvd. (Hwy. 1) south. Be in the right-hand lanes as, upon exiting the tunnel, take the Century (I-105) Freeway east. Transition onto the San Diego (I-405) Freeway south; exit at Hawthorne Blvd. (Hwy. 107, exit 42A). Turn right and proceed about 3.5 miles. The hotel will be on your right-hand side.

From Long Beach Airport: Turn right on Lakewood Blvd. as you exit the airport. Transition onto the San Diego (I-405) Freeway northbound; exit at Western Ave. (Hwy. 213, exit 38B) and head south. At Del Amo Blvd., turn right. Turn left at Hawthorne Blvd.; the hotel will be on the right-hand side.

Accommodations for Friday and Saturday nights are included in the price of your convention package. Reservations for extra nights will be made by the Kings convention staff based on your submitted paperwork. The extra room rate is \$149 plus tax per night.
